


# PRESS RELEASE

## The second wave again pauses PRINTPACK INDIA 2021



**August 3, 2021**

On Saturday, July 23, 2021, the Governing Council members of India Printing Packaging and Allied Machinery Manufacturers met in its 118<sup>th</sup> meeting to review the Survey Reports relating to the organisation of 15<sup>th</sup> PRINTPACK INDIA, slated to be held from 20 – 24 Dec 2021. During the meeting, the Governing Council had considered various relevant factors, including the Survey Reports, Government guidelines and the health-related issues of Exhibitors, Business Visitors, Service Providers etc. The House had also considered the impact of lockdowns on the industrial operations. It had also considered the postponement of significant events like Delhi Auto Expo, India ITME etc., due to COVID-19.

Initially, Governing Council made efforts and to boon the industry to participate in the 15<sup>th</sup> PRINTPACK INDIA on the dates mentioned above. Exceptional discounts were offered after the first wave of Covid. Against the regular tariff i.e. Rs. 9000 Per Sq. Mtr for Shell and Rs. 8000 for bare space, IPAMA extended up to Rs. 64% discount to Regular Members (More than 15 Years). Unfortunately, the second wave paused the momentum, and the House decided to postpone the exhibition after considering all pros & cons.
